How Much Bible to Read

A year contains 365 or 366 days, and approximately 52 weeks.

The Bible contains 1189 chapters 260 being New Testament, and 929 being Old Testament.

You could read 3 to 4 chapters a day to go through the Bible in a year's time, or read 2 to 3 chapters Monday through Friday, and take 2 years to it.

Another idea is to, read a New Testament chapter each day for Monday through Friday, and 2 to 3 Old Testament Chapters every day.

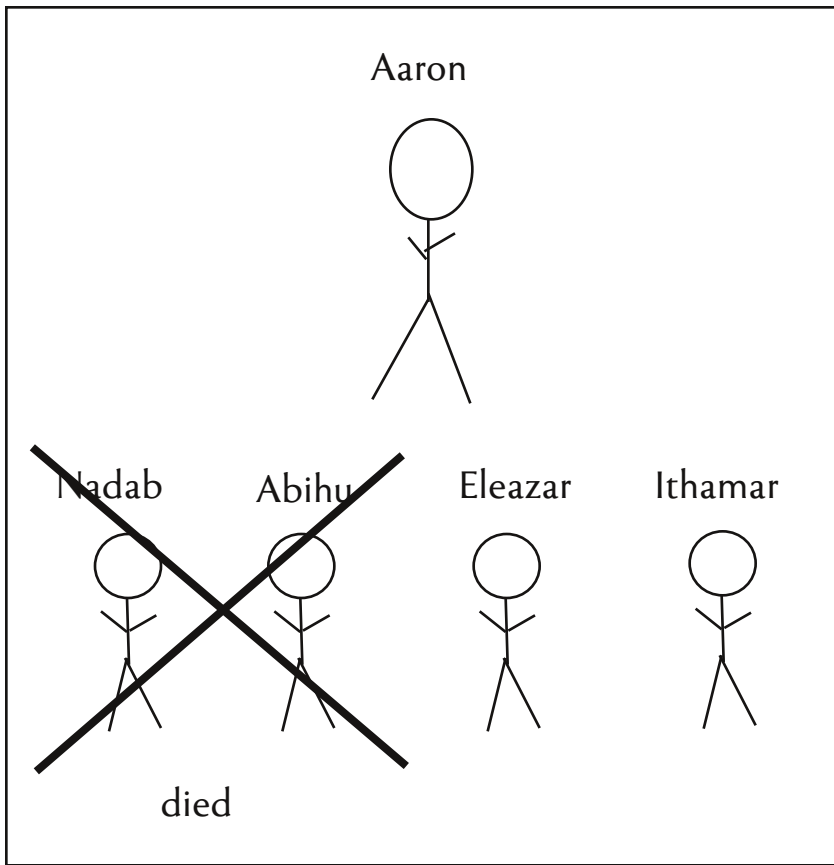
You can use any Bible reading plan you want, or go at your own speed.

There is also a plan that covers part of the Bible, reading a chapter each day, on the next page.

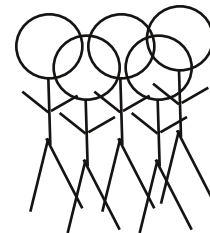
